## Informations for Teammanagers, Coaches, Players and Umpires

The Tournament will be played in accordance with the Laws of Badminton and the Competition regulations of the BWF.

- Order of play

We will play according to the time-schedule. The order of play is as detailed on the notice boards.

- Call for the match

When match control will announce to prepare for the next match mentioned players are kindly asked to come down to the arena floor and take all needs with them. There will be no marching-in for players with the umpire and the other technical officials, so the players go directly to court when called finally.

- Warming up

Warm up on court will be controlled by the umpire and is limited to 1 minute.

- Local Regulations

The height of the hall is more than 9 metres. Generally every touching by shuttle is a fault, except the obstructions which are not part of the construction of the roof.

- Shuttles

The Tournament shuttles are Yonex AS 40.

The shuttles have been tested for speed. Players are allowed to test shuttles by umpires instruction only.

Changing the shuttle during the match shall not be unfair. The umpire decides when shuttle needs to be changed.



- **Clothing**

In order to ensure attractive presentation of badminton, all clothing worn by players shall be acceptable badminton sports clothing, this means no fun or t-shirt etc.

The name / country on the shirt is not mandatory however if present it must conform to the regulations.

- **Continuos Play**

Play must be continuos from the first service until the match is concluded, except the intervals: 60 second interval at 11 and 120 second interval between games.

Players have to stay on court till match has ended.

- **Misconduct**

Umpires are instructed that the Laws and Rules have to be applied as written.

Special attention is drawn to Law 16 concerning offensive behaviour and misconduct.

Please remember that arguing about decisions taken by umpire, service judge or line judge is not allowed and can be faulted.

Players are asked to switch off their mobile phone in their bags while playing, otherwise they will get a warning (yellow card) at the first offense from the side.

- **Medical Services and Injuries**

All the time a physiotherapist is available in the hall. In case of injury the Referee will be on court and may call any assistance in case of emergency. The teammanager or the coach of the injured side is allowed on court after Referee's permission.
